# What is EduCare?

- Three Year Total Protection
  - Including Accidental Damage Protection
- Premium Battery included
  - Replacement of defective batteries up to once a year every year
- Two-way Pre-paid Freight for Depot Repairs

Type of Damage	Examples of Damage Covered
Unintentional liquid spill damage	Damage from spilled drinks
Unintentional breakage	Broken AC power pins or USB port
Drops or falls	Cracked LCD screen
Missing keyboard keys	Misplaced keyboard keys

# How does one qualify for financial hardship?

1. A student qualifies for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
  - Free or reduced Lunch
2. A student is homeless or has provided an Affidavit of Residency for enrollment purposes
3. A household is receiving Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
4. A student or any member of the student's family that lives in the home is receiving supplementary security income (SSI)
5. A student is emancipated minor

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*You may qualify if your child is eligible for the National School Lunch Program*

# Additional Resources

## GoGuardian

- **Constant Protection:** The Internet is always “on”—your filtering software should be, too. GoGuardian protects your students (and your devices) around the clock—both inside and outside the classroom.
- **Screen Viewer** — live stream of students’ screens in a single window.
- **Activity Timeline** — real-time and historic insight into when, where, and how students are using devices.
- **Tab Control** — instantly send one or more students to a specific website in a new tab.
- **Attention Mode** — close tabs, darken screens, or lock devices for “eyes up front” focus.

## Shell Case

**Additional Protection:** The shell case will snap onto the Chromebook to add an additional layer of protection to the Chromebook, and allow students to personalize the surface of the shell if desired.
