



# Pennsbury's Art Goes To School Program Is Seeking Volunteers !

**T**he Art Goes To School Program is a non-profit organization that provides visual art appreciation to elementary schools in the Delaware Valley region of Pennsylvania and New Jersey. The Pennsbury School District's chapter of AGTS is seeking volunteers to teach art appreciation classes at the ten elementary schools. Our program introduces the children to 20 prints of art from around the world dating from the prehistoric period to the present. During our 45 minute classroom sessions, the children learn about the artists' lives and their work. We encourage the children to respond to art and share their ideas and feelings by playing games and through class discussions.

Training is provided. You don't need to have experience in art history or teaching. We all learn about famous artists and their paintings in free workshops and then communicate to the most enthusiastic listeners ever – young children. The time commitment is 1 to 2 hours a month during the school year and it's on a flexible schedule that you create. We are also a part of the larger organization that enables us to go on field trips and attend lectures at many local Philadelphia Museums.
