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### **Assistant Principals Approved by Pennsbury School Board**

In this capacity, Mr. Regensburg planned and executed all logistics related to hiring, the master schedule, individual grade level staff and student schedules, and compliance for opening school for the 2017-2018 school year. He also taught Health and Physical Education at Pottstown Middle School and served as the K-12 Department Chair.
