- (a) An apprenticeship training program registered within the past ten (10) years; or
- (b) An apprenticuship program registered within the past ten (10) years if the program provides apprenticeship training for a crait or made that was not recognized as an apprenticeship craft or trade by the U.S. Department of Labor or State Apprenticeship Council at the time the program was registered.

Any program not required to meet the graduation requirements of this section shall; in addition to providing proof that it is currently registered with federal or state government, provide evidence that the program is actively engaged in bona fide apprendiceship training activity.
