Title: Tuition Students

Purpose: This policy establishes the conditions under which tuition students may be accepted and enrolled in Pennsbury schools.

This document, Index No. 202.1, replaces former Board Procedure 1900 of December 21, 1976.

Definition: A “tuition student” is a non-resident student who obtains his/her education in the Pennsbury School District and pays tuition.

Policy: Eligibility

The Pennsbury School District will not accept a tuition student unless the student attended Pennsbury as a resident student and decided to remain a Pennsbury student after the family moved from the School District. To be eligible the following requirements must be met:

1. No break in attendance may occur.
2. The parents or guardians must assume all financial responsibility for payment of tuition on a monthly basis with the June reconciliation payment to cover either overpayment or underpayment as the case may be.
3. Transportation of the student shall be the responsibility of the parents or guardians.
4. Tuition must be paid one month in advance.
5. Failure to make a required payment will result in the disenrollment of the student from the Pennsbury School District.

Records and Reports

There will be no records sent or report cards given until all tuition is paid and other obligations are completed.

Relocation after April 30

A student whose family moves from the School District after April 30 shall be carried as resident students of the School District until the end of the school year.

The transportation of these students shall be the responsibility of a student's parents or guardians.

Homes Under Construction

The Pennsbury School District will accept students as resident students if the parents or guardians are in the process of building a home in the School District and the home will be completed within 60 days of the first day of attendance of the student. Unavoidable delays in construction may be cause for an extension.

Tuition Rate

The rate of tuition to be charged is the rate established for the prior year.
