Title: Facilities Dedication

Purpose: To establish policies for dedication requests.

This document, Index No. 701.2, replaces the previous Index No. 6575 with no change in the language.

Background: Dedication or re-dedication of any facility or portion of a facility within the School District in someone's honor is special recognition by the School District and must be approved by a vote of the Board of School Directors within an established time period.

Policy:

1. Requests to name or re-name a facility within the School District in someone's honor must be passed by a two-thirds majority vote of the full School Board.
2. A consideration period of at least two years will be imposed for the passage of any such request, beginning at the time the School Board is formally presented with the request in writing.
3. Qualifications of potential honorees will not be formally established although honorees should exhibit or have exhibited significant involvement with the School District either as a student, teacher, principal, administrator, employee, School Board member or donor. Candidates may be living or deceased.
