Title: Gifts, Grants, Donations

Purpose: This policy sets forth the conditions and circumstances under which the School Board will accept contributions from individuals and organizations.

This document, Index No. 702.1, replaces the previous Index No. 5300R1.

Policy: The School District may accept any bequest or gift of money or property for a purpose deemed to be suitable, and to utilize such money or property so designated. To be acceptable, a gift must satisfy the following criteria:

1. The gift must be serviceable, in good repair and useful to School District educational or support processes.
2. The gift must not be inappropriate or harmful to students or staff members.
3. The gift must not imply endorsement of any business product, religion, political party or controversial agency.
4. The gift must not be in conflict with any provision of the Public School Code or other public law.
5. All gifts shall become the sole property of the School District.
6. Acceptance of a gift does not imply agreement with the use or placement requested by the donor. The School Board reserves the right to utilize gifts at its sole discretion.

Class Gifts to Schools

This policy shall apply to class and student gifts to schools.

PTO Gifts to Schools

Gifts of parent-teacher organizations (PTO's) to schools shall be handled in accordance with this policy, except for PTO Partnership Projects, which are addressed in Procedure 908.1.
