During the past 37 seasons at Pennsbury HS Coach McSherry has molded the Falcon softball program into a perennial power in the Suburban One League, PIAA District One and in Pennsylvania Class AAAA. He has permanently placed himself among the elite high school softball coaches in the area. He has been named Coach of the Year in the SOL, Bucks County Courier Times and The Trentonian many times. During Coach McSherry's tenure, Pennsbury has captured 5 PIAA state championships which is the most of any large school in the state. Add to that many Suburban One League and District One Championships and his 600+ wins as a coach. Coach McSherry's strengths lie in his attention to detail in playing the game, positive communication and love for teaching his players to be successful.

Bristol High School Head Coach

34th Season

Coach Lalli has led the Lady Warriors softball program at Bristol HS for the last 3 decades. During that time Bristol HS has been known as one of the best small school softball programs in Pennsylvania. Under Coach Lalli, Bristol has captured 25 BAL league Championships, 19 PIAA District One Championships and a PIAA state title. The team has won every BAL title since the 2000 season. Coach Lalli has over 500 wins in his career this season. He has been named BAL Coach of the year 18 times and Bucks County Courier Times Coach of the year 6 times. His strengths are a focus on fundamentals, playing the game the right way and positive communication with his players.
