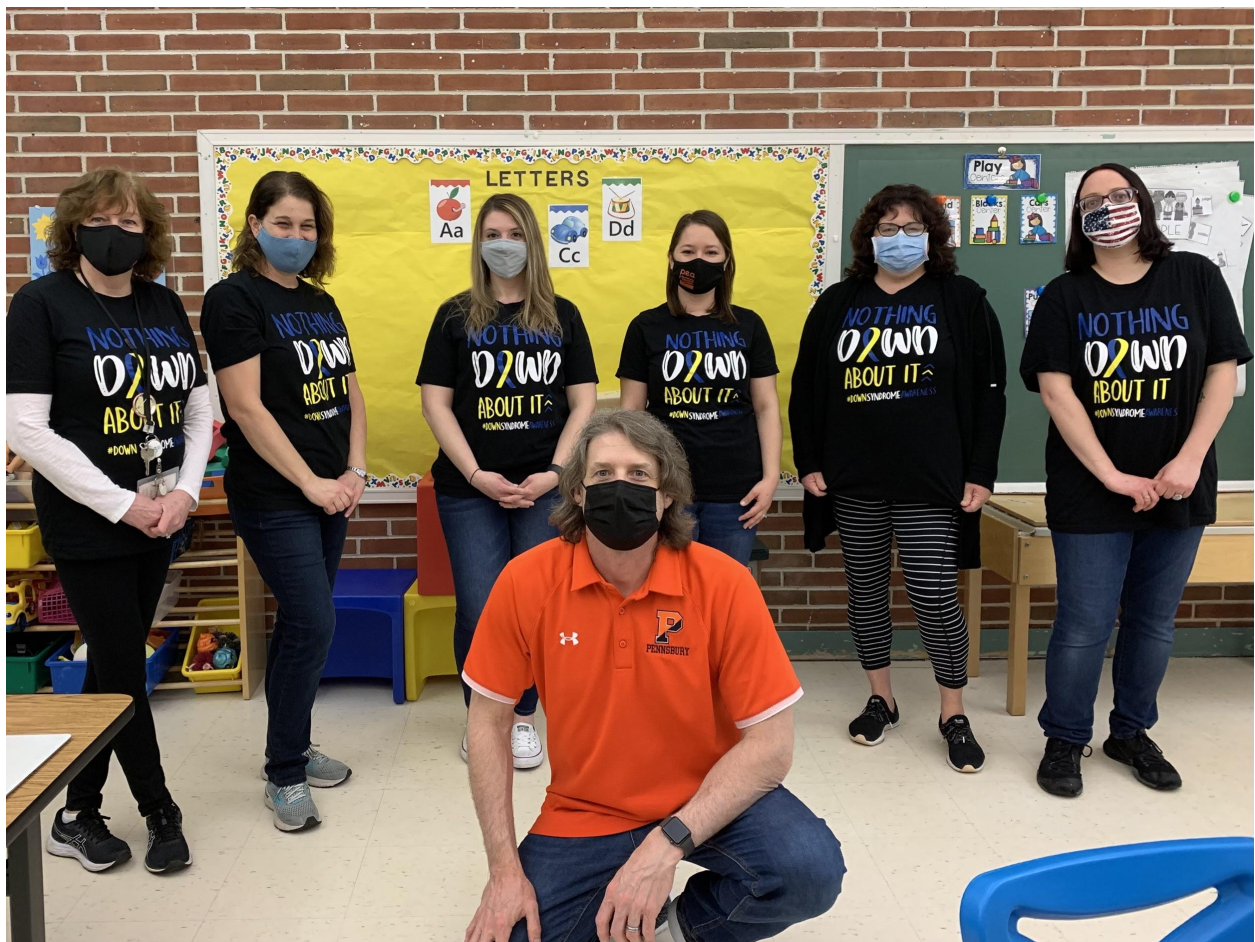


Nothing DOWN About it!
