



The Pennsbury School District Remote Learning Program Family Guidelines for Elementary Students

DAILY PARTICIPATION EXPECTATIONS

1. Your homeroom teacher will provide you with a code to access your Google Classroom. Remember we are taking attendance and it is expected that you will be in "Remote School" Daily
2. Be sure to have a quiet workplace in order to participate in remote learning, free of distractions, like the TV or a video game.
3. When your teacher is providing live instruction make sure your camera is on and microphones are muted.
4. Teachers will take attendance during the Morning Meeting through the Google Classroom.
5. Report any concerns about the assignments to your teacher.

ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS

1. Check your Google Classroom daily for asynchronous assignments.
2. Participate in discussions, activities and classwork assignments.
3. Complete all assignments and turn them in on time.
4. The traditional elementary grading guidelines will be used to show student progress. [Elementary Report Card Brochure](#)
5. Do your own work and don't be afraid to ask questions if you don't understand something.
6. Your teacher may invite you to a small group session to review material and/or provide you with additional help with new concepts
7. Synchronous sessions will be recorded and available if a student misses class or would like to review it again later. These will be posted in the teacher's Google Classroom.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

1. School and classroom rules apply in the virtual instructional environment.
2. Students are expected to be dressed appropriately each day and be ready to learn.
3. No videos or recordings of any group sessions or teacher instruction is permitted.
