

Dear Parents,

Many parents ask, "What can I do over the summer?" for my child. A good question.....

1. Please continue with flash cards and helping your child with their basic math facts.
Entering Kindergarten: Work with numbers to 5; counting objects, working with sets of 5 and number recognition to 10, exposure to 30. Entering 1st grade: Mastery of addition and subtraction facts to 5: Exposure of addition and subtraction facts to 10. Entering 2nd grade: Mastery of addition and subtraction facts to 10. Exposure of addition and subtraction facts to 20. Entering 3rd grade: Mastery of addition and subtraction facts to 20: Exposure of Multiplication and Division facts. Entering 4th grade: Mastery of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division fact. Entering 5th grade: Continue to reinforce mastery of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division facts.
2. Continue with the on-line Compass Learning and XtraMath computer programs.
3. Everyday Math 4 website: Allow your child to play the games. Remember that this will be discontinued at the end of July when the company promotes student to the next grade. Access will not begin again until the new school year.
4. Math packets for children entering their next grade: Click on the link provided to print a packet of skills to review over the summer. Please choose the packet that applies to your child.
