Ms. Lisa Follman is honored to be the new Principal of Eleanor Roosevelt Elementary School. The 2015-16 school year will mark her tenth year as a school administrator, including five years serving with the administrative team here in Pennsbury.

Ms. Follman began her career with the Bristol Township School District as an English teacher and teacher of the gifted. In 2003, she joined the Pennsbury High School English Department where she taught all levels 9-12, including students in Advanced Placement English. She was then selected to be an Assistant Principal for

William Tennent High School in the Centennial School District in January 2007. In addition to supervising students and staff at WTHS, Ms. Follman was responsible for master scheduling as well as curriculum and instruction in the areas of English, English as a Second Language, Reading, Gifted Support, and World Languages.

Pennsbury welcomed Ms. Follman back in 2010 as an Assistant Principal at Pennsbury High School and Supervisor of School Counseling K-12. In this dual role, she worked to improve college admissions and the communication between the School Counseling Department and the school community. This unique assignment also offered Ms. Follman the opportunity to expand her work to the elementary and middle levels with a focus on the social and emotional well-being of all students K-12. During this time, Ms. Follman was appointed to serve as a member of the Internal Leadership Team responsible for developing the 2013-2016 District Comprehensive Plan, a role she has resumed in the development of the 2016-2019 Plan.

In early 2015, Ms. Follman was given the opportunity to serve as Supervisor of Special Education at Edgewood Elementary School and Charles Boehm Middle School. Her experiences working with the students, families, and teachers from these schools reinforced her deep appreciation for the Pennsbury school experience and the matching commitment from Pennsbury families.

Ms. Follman holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in English and a Master's degree in Education, both from Temple University. She was awarded her Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction PK-12 and Principal PK-12 certifications while earning her Master's degree in Educational Leadership from Lehigh University.
