**NEW BUSINESS**

**A. VILLAGE PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

At the June 21, 2018 Board meeting, the Board voted to terminate the lease agreement with Lifeworks at the former Village Park Elementary School.

If the Board is in agreement, the following motion is in order:

**MOTION:** Move that the Board recommends that the Pennsbury School District re-open the former Village Park Elementary School as Village Park Academy. Village Park Academy will house students in grades 4 to 12 who require Emotional and Behavioral Support. In doing so, the Board directs the administration to make appropriate revisions to the District's Special Education Plan.
