WHAT IS ROTARY?

Rotary is a worldwide organization of business and professional leaders that provides humanitarian service, encourages high ethical standards in all vocations, and helps build goodwill and peace in the world.

Approximately 1.2 million Rotarians belong to more than 32,000 Rotary clubs located in 166 countries. Rotary clubs meet weekly, are nonpolitical, nonreligious, and open to all cultures, races and creeds. The Levittown-Fairless Hills Rotary Club has always exemplified the Rotary motto of "Service Above Self" since its incorporation in 1955.



THE ROTARY CLUB OF LEVITTOWN-FAIRLESS HILLS is making an impact in our local community.

- We present at our breakfast meetings interesting and informative speakers from within our community who impact our community.
- We conduct, in cooperation with the students and faculty at Pennsbury Elementary Schools, as area food drive for the Emergency Homeless Shelter-raising over 2 tons of canned and dry goods for our community's most needy.
- We partnered with the Sunshine Foundation to make the dream visiting a Florida theme park come true for a deserving little girl and her family.
- We were awarded the "Non-Profit of the Year" in 2012 by The Pennsbury Partner's program!
- We donated \$6000 to the Levittown-Fairless Hills Rescue Squad for the purchase of life-saving EZ-I0 needles.
- We sponsor a high school service club, The Interact Club at Pennsbury High School, a Rotary sanctioned club of involved students that earn service hours through service to others; learning the importance of taking care of the community.
- We recognize a "student of the month" from one of three schools in our area. The award goes to a student who exemplifies not only academic achievement but also gives of their time in service to others.
- We award annual scholarships to deserving students from Pennsbury, Conwell Egan and Bucks County Tech. HS as they begin their post high school education.
- We conduct a monthly program at the Bucks County Homeless Shelter where Rotarians read, conduct a craft project or other activities for the children.
- Working through Rotoplast, a Rotary International program, we provided for the repair of a Vietnamese child's cleft palate.
- When the earthquake hit Haiti, we contributed funds to send Shelter Boxes to those affected. Shelter Boxes provide a tent, cooking utensils and other necessities for survival in time of disaster.
- We have contributed thousands of dollars through our fund raising efforts and individual member contributions to eliminate polio throughout the world. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation donated over \$200 Million dollars to this effort and Rotarians around the world matched their donation. Only three countries remain to eradicate polio completely. In 2011, Rotary's effort to immunize people in India has led to the first year in which there were no new cases of polio in India!
