



Pennsbury's Special Education Parent Advisory Council (SEPAC) will be conducting two simultaneous information sessions on **Wednesday, May 4, 2022, at 6:30 pm** at Pennsbury High School West.

The first session is geared toward elementary and middle school level parents and is about **MTSS, or Multi-Tiered Support Systems**. MTSS is a three-tiered framework that begins with a foundation of strong core instruction and universal supports, followed by intensified interventions matched to student needs based on the continuous use of data and progress monitoring. This session will take place at **Falcon Cafeteria at PHS West**.

The second session is geared toward high school level parents and is about **Transition Planning for Special Education Students**. Transition Planning is an individualized plan that is supported by the student's support team. Transition Coordinator Sarah Worthington will present information about everything from course selection to employment, as well as students' transition out of an educational environment and how to prepare for their future. This session will take place at **Keller Hall at PHS West**.
