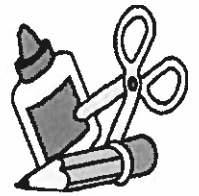




**AFTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

12 #2 Pencils (Sharpened)  
1 Pencil sharpener  
1 3-pack of glue sticks (Elmers)  
1 box of crayons- Twistables style  
1 box of colored pencils- either regular  
or Twistables  
1 scissors (kid size, pointed)  
4 Dry Erase Expo Markers (thin)  
1 Whiteboard eraser (old socks work  
great!)  
1 set of headphones (NOT earbuds and  
NOT wireless)

**3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**

Headphones  
White board markers and an eraser

- 1 Blue Single Subject Notebook
- 1 Red Single Subject Notebook
- 1 Yellow Single Subject Notebook
- \*Colors are suggested, not mandatory*
- 1 Folder
- 1 Marble Composition Book
- 1 Pack of #2 Pencils (sharpened)
- 1 Highlighter
- 1 Box of Markers
- 1 Box of Colored Pencils
- 1 Box of Expo Markers and a sock/rag for erasing
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 3 Glue Sticks
- 1 soft zippered pencil case (optional)
- 1 Pair of Headphones or Earbuds

### **5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- Headphones (for lessons)
- Pencils
- Paper
- Pens
- Expo marker
- Highlighter

### **RECOMMENDED ART SUPPLIES**

- 9 x 12 White Paper (Preferably something kids can draw/paint on like white construction paper or white drawing paper) Printer paper is ok but not ideal.
- Small pack of colored Construction or Printer Paper
- Crayons (24 pack or more)
- Pencil/Eraser/Sharpener
- 2-3 Fine Point Sharpie Markers, black
- Scissors
- Glue stick or bottle
- Large paper as "Messy Mat" placemat to work on top of (newspaper, wrapping paper, brown kraft paper)
- 1 Empty Oatmeal container, Cereal box, Gift box, Small amazon box

### **Helpful for students:**

- Colored Pencils (24 pack or more)
- Markers (colored)
- Watercolors paint set (8 colors or more)
- Water bowl (any container with low sides and flat bottom is best to prevent spills)
- Paintbrush
- Colored Chalk
