Earlier this year, I wrote to you regarding our efforts to improve the safety and security of our students and staff. As we continue to improve our district communication, we are planning to conduct a system-wide test of our notification system this week.

On **Wednesday, at 4:00 pm**, we will send a test phone call, email, and text message to all of the phone numbers and email addresses we have in our PowerSchool system. If you do not receive the message in all three ways, [please complete this form](#).

Please Note:

In the event of an actual emergency, you will be notified immediately via phone, email, and text via our alert system. A follow-up communication will be sent as soon as possible with specific details regarding the event. In the event of an actual emergency, please understand the following district safety guidelines:

- *Do not come to the school and/or try to enter or pick up your child; all doors will be locked and monitored by emergency staff.*
- *Do not call the school or district offices - district phones need to stay open for emergency communication.*
- *Communication will be through emails, calls, and texts from the district.*
- *An evacuation and reunification process is established and will be shared if needed.*

In closing, I would like to remind you that Pennsbury uses [Safe2Say](#), an anonymous tip line, to alert us to any individual who may be struggling and/or in danger of causing harm to themselves or others. Every tip is investigated.

You have my commitment that we will continue to work hard to ensure that we are doing all that we can to keep our students and schools as safe as possible.
