Dear Pennsbury School Community,

Earlier today, the Bucks County Superintendents met with the County Office of Emergency Management (OEM) to review the potential impact of this storm on travel and flooding tomorrow morning. Based on the information shared, the Pennsbury School District will operate on a 2-hour delay tomorrow morning.

- Two-hour delay start times are as follows:
 - Pennsbury High School: 9:20 am
 - Middle Schools: 10:10 am
 - Elementary schools: 11:00 am
 - KidsCare will open at 9:00 am
- Buses will arrive at stops two hours later than usual, and school will begin two hours later than usual.
- High School Keystone Exams will be postponed from Wednesday to Thursday. More information will be shared by the high school.
- Note to walking students: Some sidewalks and intersections may be flooded and difficult to cross. Please plan accordingly.
- PLEASE NOTE: This decision will be reevaluated during the overnight hours to determine the impact of the storm. If needed, any further changes will be communicated around 7:00 a.m. through the following portals: Phone call, email, text, Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, and the [district website](#). Information is usually posted online before the phone call and email.
- **If you do not receive any additional alerts from the district, we are following a 2 hour delay.**
