


The black bar at the top of the page contains website channels that hold information unique to each channel. These channels vary slightly on the school sites.




Student schedules will not be available through Power School until later this month. Any schedules that may have been viewed are NOT finalized and are subject to change.

Click on "District home" to return to the main page of the District site. Navigate to schools sites by clicking on "Our Schools."




Click on the "Home" to return to the main page of the website you are viewing. Translate the site into different languages by clicking "Translate Language."




Important or Emergency Messages will automatically appear when visiting the website. Click the "OK, got it." button to clear the message.











Pennsbury School District is comprised of four municipalities located in the southeastern corner of Bucks County, Pennsylvania: Yardley Borough, Lower Makefield Township, Falls Township, and Tullytown Borough. The economically-diverse community residents range from industrial workers to professionals who commute daily to New York City and Philadelphia. With an enrollment of approximately 10,072, Pennsbury School District currently has ten elementary schools (K-5), three middle schools (6-8), and one high school with two campus buildings. Our ethnic composition of enrollment is as follows: American Indian: 0.74%; Asian: 7.76%; Black or African American: 7.60%; Hispanic or Latino: 3.86%; Multi-Racial: 4.35%; Pacific Islander: .14%, and White 75.55%.




### **Board of School Directors**

Members of the Board of School Directors and School District staff appreciate your interest in the Board meetings and business of the Pennsbury school system. Public understanding, participation, and communication are vital to a successful educational environment for students in Pennsbury. You are encouraged to read the minutes of recent meetings and anticipate agenda items of the next meeting to assist in your active participation.

The Board is comprised of nine residents, each elected for a two-year or four-year term. Two student members (nonvoting) are appointed according to state guidelines. Anyone who is 18 years old, a citizen of the United States for three months, and a resident of the School District for 30 days, is eligible to vote in School Board elections. Any qualified voter who is 21 years old may stand for election to the Board.



Each website (District and schools) has a "Headlines and Information" section. Check this area frequently for district/school news and important updates.


