Arthur J. Lendo, PhD. is a distinguished Pennsbury alumnus with a true sense of loyalty to his alma mater. A member of the Class of 1964, he is the first and only Pennsbury graduate to endow a fund to support PHS students in their academic and co-curricular pursuits. While attending Pennsbury in the early 1960s, Dr. Lendo was not only a student scholar, but he also became a Falcon sports standout. He captained both the baseball and basketball teams in 1964 and later entered the Pennsbury Athletic Hall of Fame as a member of the inaugural class. Dr. Lendo achieved outstanding academic and professional success beyond his Pennsbury career. He is counted among the most experienced college presidents in the United States, having served as President of Peirce College in Philadelphia from 1991-2009. Dr. Lendo hopes to inspire today's Pennsbury students to become great leaders, acquire the skills necessary to achieve in a global society, and to share knowledge with their peers.

- Attach a resume of your school and community activities. Include the length of time you have been involved and any leadership positions you have held.

Lendo Fellowship awards are made by the Pennsbury Education Foundation. Not every worthy applicant is able to receive an award and awards often do not cover the full cost of participation. Preference is given to applicants in ninth, tenth and eleventh grades.

In the past three years, PEF awarded on average 20 Lendo Fellowship recipients with award amounts ranging from \$100 to \$2500. Moving forward, funds are available to provide a greater award amount on a more selective basis.

Applications can be submitted to either Pennsbury High School Counseling Office at any time but must be submitted no later than **April 1**.
