Remember to Follow These Safety Rules



Walkers:

- Plan a safe route and stick to it
- Always walk with an adult or a friend
- Don't push or chase each other near the street
- Don't accept rides if not arranged and confirmed by a parent
- Watch for cars at every driveway and intersection

Bikers:

- Anyone under the age of 12 must wear a helmet when riding a bicycle. The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation strongly recommends that all bicyclists wear helmets whenever they ride.
- Look both ways for traffic
- Make sure your tires have air in them
- Use a backpack to carry your belongings
- Always lock your bike up
- Always ride with a friend
