Here is how families can grow literacy skills over the summer:

In order to promote a life-long love of literacy, reading and writing must continue throughout the summer. With this in mind, Pennsbury's elementary schools have developed a summer reading program in which all students are required to read.

- Students entering Grades 1 and 2 are required to read 5-10 books (depending upon length).
- All students must complete and return one postcard (attached) about one of their summer reading books.
- All students who fulfill the summer reading requirement will be invited to a reading celebration!
